Recruitment Enhancement Core (REC) Services

Below is a breakdown of our levels of service (all of which are cumulative).

Level 1 Services (Study Registration):

Level 1 services include referrals from the **Research Participant Registry**, a posting at vfh.wustl.edu, Centerwatch.com and on our Facebook Fanpage, and flyer/poster development

Level 2 Services (Media Development and Placement):

Level 2 services include development of print media ads, radio and TV ads(on/off campus and paid/free), IRB approval support for REC and sponsor generated ads, and email blast distribution.

Level 3 Services (Strategic Plan Development/Accountability):

Level 3 services include consultation on protocol feasibility, template language for regulatory and budget preparation, strategic recruitment plan development and guidance, and recruitment plan accountability.

Level 4 Services (Strategic Plan Implementation):

Level 4 services include strategic plan implementation which includes patient chart reviews by engaged REC staff (Allscripts, Clin Desk, Cider), potential participant pre-screening and referrals, creation and implementation of IRB approved pre-screening tools and/or scripts, monthly enrollment analysis, and referral network collaboration with targeted community medical professionals.

****The only time the REC would need to be reimbursed for services is when REC staff are responsible for implementing the strategic recruitment plan (Level 4 services).****
