Explore the revised Center for Clinical Research Ethics (<u>CCRE</u>) webpage. The Center provides <u>consultation</u> on research ethics, training and research design. The CCRE also provides administrative support for the <u>Interdisciplinary Bioethics Network</u> (IBN) at Washington University through an integrated calendar of events and an IBN Associate database.

SPARC Funding Program Announcement

• The ICTS announces collaboration with the Indiana University Clinical and Translational Science Institute (ICTSI) as well as other academic institutions and pharmaceutical companies to offer the Strategic Pharma-Academic Research Consortium (SPARC) Funding Program. Initially focused on advancing research, new medicines and/or personalized medicine for autoimmune diseases, the RFP is open to Washington University investigators. Awards will provide up to \$400,000 for up to 2 years. Application instructions are available on the ICTS website, but applications are to be submitted directly to Indiana.
